Whether you're squaring off with the morning grind or venturing out to the beach for a weekend adventure, versatility is a must. If you're looking for a sporty yet efficient car that was built to do it all, the Honda Civic can't be overlooked.

Across its many trim levels and configurations, the Civic offers up a bevy of amenities and styling choices. Some options are made more for the consummate athlete, and others for the eco-conscious drivers.

In this detailed buyer's guide to the Honda Civic, we'll cover all the highlights, showing you just what this sleek ride is capable of!

Civic Style: Choosing the Right Model

While the high performance of the Civic is consistent across all trims and models, you'll find that the overall look of your car changes drastically depending on which body style you choose. You'll have three different options to choose from: Sedan, Coupe, or Hatchback.

The Civic **Sedan** is your classic 4-door model. Extra roomy and easily accessible from the front and back, it's a great choice for any crew that frequently features second-row passengers.

If you most often drive solo or with only a co-pilot up front, the Civic **Coupe** is an excellent choice. Without the rear doors, it presents a more steeply sloped rear, one that closely resembles the fastback automobile of the 1950s or 1960s.

Lastly, the Civic **Hatchback** is an exceptional choice for drivers that need a little bit of added cargo space. Not only does the hatch make loading up your luggage or shopping bags easier, it also offers up more space to do so.

Civic Coupe Variant: The Si

The standard Civic Coupe has a distinctly sporty look. However, things are really kicked into high gear in the Civic Si Coupe variant. The interior and exterior are both updated with exclusive sport accents such as the body-color rear spoiler. Performance gets a boost, too, with its 6-speed manual transmission and the 205-horsepower turbocharged engine.

Civic Hatchback Variant: The Type R

Much like the Si Coupe variant, the Type R Hatchback variant employs a sportier look with a body-color rear spoiler and red exterior accents. Its racetrack DNA asserts itself boldly with 306 horsepower and 295 lb-ft of torque. If it's pure speed and curve-controlled handling that you're looking for, the Type R has that and so much more.



The Honda Civic: A Well-Balanced Ride

While we know that the Coupe and Hatchback models and their sport variants are built with high power in mind, what does the popular Sedan offer up? To put it simply: balance. The Civic Sedan is an eco-conscious commuter that ekes out great gas mileage without neglecting horsepower. Across its trim levels, you'll find two different engines available.

2.0L Inline 4-Cylinder

Standard in the base LX trim and the Sport trim, you'll find the 2.0L 4-cylinder engine. In an effort to beat out many other compact Sedans in its class, it's primed to generate 158 horsepower and 138 lb-ft of torque. In a car like this Sedan, that kind of power equates to pure pep.

2.0L Inline 4-Cylinder with Turbocharging

If it's something of an upgrade you're looking for, you'll want to opt for the turbocharged 4-cylinder that is found in the EX, EX-L, and Touring trim levels. It ups horsepower to 174 and amps up torque considerably to 162 lb-ft. The additional power makes it easier to accelerate quicker as you merge onto the highway during your morning commute.

Maximum Fuel Efficiency

Power such as what the two Civic Sedan engines provide is made all the sweeter when it is balanced by high fuel efficiency. You'll actually find the top MPG in the EX and EX-L trim levels with the turbocharged engine. Pair this powertrain with a Continuously Variable Transmission and you'll maintain an EPA-estimated 42 MPG highway, 32 MPG city, and 36 combined.¹





Smart Safety to Combat the Roughest Roads

Across its many configurations, the Honda Civic has a ton of highlights. However, one that you'll see popping up time and again is its expansive safety array. In addition to being constructed with Advanced Compatibility Engineering™, a body structure that deflects and absorbs impact forces, the Civic offers up a number of protective technologies.

Perhaps the most extensive safety array in the Civic is the Honda Sensing® suite, which comes standard in all its trim levels. This suite runs on a network of sensors and small cameras that monitor the roads around your vehicle. They can read road markings, calculate following distances, and more. If the suite predicts a collision is imminent, it can even act autonomously to keep you safe.

Honda Sensing® Safety Features

- **Collision Mitigation Braking System™:** If a frontal collision is unavoidable, your Civic will hit the brakes for you.
- **Road Departure Mitigation System:** When you veer out of your intended lane without using a turn signal, the vehicle will course correct and steer you back into place.
- **Adaptive Cruise Control with Low-Speed Follow:** This feature measures following distances when engaged and will hit the brakes if the car in front of you does the same.
- **Lane Keeping Assist System:** During long drives, this feature provides consistent steering assist to keep you centered in your lane.

Honda LaneWatch™

In addition to standard Honda Sensing®, top trims of the Civic also come with the Honda LaneWatch™ system. It helps you see that the coast is clear during right turns by projecting a live video feed of your blind spot on the central touchscreen. With this feature on your side, you shouldn't have to worry about turning or merging into another car.

Interior Elegance for All Tastes

The Honda Civic is a cozy 5-seater, making it a great choice for small families or a driver with a close group of friends. Its standard cloth seating and roomy 97.8 cubic feet of passenger space mean that even in the base trim, you'll have plenty of room to stretch out and relax during your longest drives. Nevertheless, if you're looking to up your cabin comfort, these upgrades were made to delight.

Classy Leather Appointments

If cloth seating isn't to your taste, no worries. Leather appointments are available in numerous colors for a stain-free option that is as breathable as it is chic. You can also add in leather wraps to the steering wheel and shift knob for uniformity.

Power Heated Seating

The most comfortable driver's seat is the one that really hugs and contours your body. The available 8-way power-adjustable seat in the Civic allows drivers to more finely configure their seating position and ensure they're at peak comfort.
